DG, National Museum

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A virtual museum tour will allow the visitors to explore the National Museum collections online through digital technology. The proposed virtual museum experiences will include 360-degree views, high-resolution artwork images, and interactive exhibitions of all the collections which can be accessed from any device with internet connectivity.

Terms & Conditions for the Quotation:

- 1. **Eligibility**: The agency may be a private/public company, a proprietary or partnership firm or a not-for-profit organisation like a Registered Society or a Charitable trust. It must have with an expertise in creating 360 Degree Virtual tours of educational institutions and/or heritage sites and registered at least for 3 years as on 31 December 2024.
- 2. **Scope of Work**: The National Museum has 31 Galleries in its campus at Janpath, New Delhi. The agency will require to quote price per gallery and the campus. The work will include:
 - a. A 360 Degree Virtual Tour of each Gallery and the campus (Outdoor) on a professional 360 Degree software preferably 3D Vista or KR Pano. The 360 degree virtual tour work of the campus will be treated as equivalent to 1 gallery. Each gallery may have 10-20 points for 360 degree views (panoramas) and 30-50 Showcases/Large Objects/Framed Artworks (paintings, manuscripts etc.).
 - b. High-Resolution Photograph of each Gallery Showcase/Large Object/Framed Artwork and its write up by a professional 24 megapixel DSLR camera and its linking in the virtual tour through a pop-up window and photo-slider (for multiple objects).
 - c. A downloadable PDF of each write-up in a Gallery with its audio in English and Hindi will be provided in all Virtual Tours.
 - d. Floor plan of the National Museum and its each Gallery with panoramas linked on it. The 2D Floor Plans of the National Museum and the Galleries and a 3D model of the National Museum will be provided by the National Museum.
 - e. A Catalogue of each Gallery in the form of an online flipbook with its downloadable PDF.
 - f. An online interactive E-Brochure of the Museum Collections providing links to the 360 Virtual Tours of their respective galleries.
 - g. 360 Degree Video (2 minutes) of each Gallery.
 - h. Creation of an Introductory Video of 3-4 minutes on mobile phone of each gallery by an expert. The expert will be provided by the National Museum.
 - i. A webpage providing links of all the 360 Virtual Tours with their introduction.
 - j. Provisions of the Images and write-ups of all the collections covered in the above 360 Degree Virtual Tours in the format of "Jatan" online database.

- 3. **Sample 360 Degree Virtual Tour**: At least one 360 Virtual Tour of a Heritage Site or an Educational/Training Institution shall be provided by the applicant.
- 4. **Duration and Delivery**: The Virtual Tours of all 31 Galleries and the Campus will be created and delivered in two months from the date of award of the work.
- 5. **Payment**: Payment will be made on satisfactory completion of the 360 Degree Tour of a gallery/campus.
- 6. **Online Catalogues/Flipbooks**: Wherever the images of the artefacts/collections are available, the National Museum will provide them to be linked as pop-up images in the 360 degree virtual tours of the galleries and in the online catalogues/flipbooks.
